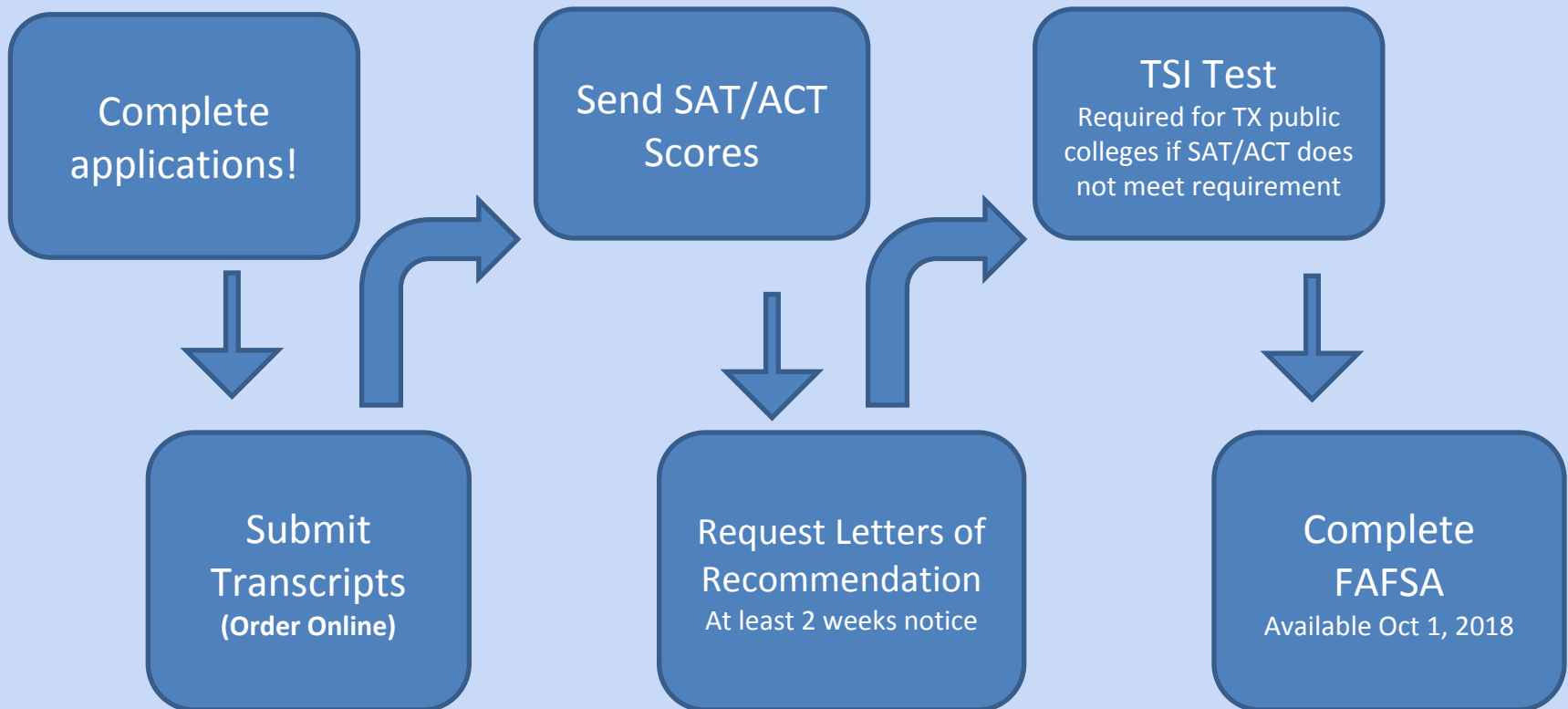

# **FACTORS COLLEGES CONSIDER FOR ADMISSION**

- **GPA and Class Rank**
- **SAT and/or ACT scores**
- **Essays**
- **Activity Resumes**
- **Strength of Student's Current Schedule and History**
- **Letters of Recommendations**
- **Meeting the Published Deadlines**
- **Other Personal Factors**

# **Additional Steps**

- Research colleges and their requirements, deadlines, etc.
- Complete your Required Essays
- Bacterial Meningitis Vaccine
- FAFSA & Scholarship Applications

# **CLASS RANK, GPA, AND COLLEGE ADMISSION**

- **Colleges use 6th semester rank and GPA for admissions purposes (end of 11th grade) (preliminary rank)**
- **If class rank and/or GPA improve after the first semester of 12th grade, colleges can review that information. (official)**
- **Texas Top 10% Rule**
- **Class of 2019 - Top 6% for UT Austin only**

# SAT/ACT

- SAT/ACT are college entrance exams are required to be admitted into a 4 year university.
- Scores must be sent directly to college/university by student.
- SAT - [www.collegeboard.org](http://www.collegeboard.org)
- ACT - [www.act.org](http://www.act.org)
- If you qualify for free/reduced lunch, you can get some college applications fees waived.

# AP EXAMS

- AP Exams will be administered May 2019
- A score of 1 - 5 is given on an AP exam
- A score of 3 or higher will be awarded college credit through college board

# RESUME TIPS

- Make it easy to read
- Use a chronological format
- List school-related and non school-related activities
  - Extracurricular activities
  - Community service, volunteer work
  - Leadership positions, offices held
  - Work experience, internships, summer programs
  - Scholarships, awards, honors, recognition

# LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

- Fill out Letter of Recommendation Packet.
- Request letter and turn in LOR Packet to your counselor with at least two weeks notice.
- Provide Counselor with stamped, addressed envelope. Counselor will not give you your letter of recommendation.
